

Crop(s) **Peanut**
Disease(s) **Leaf spot, rust, net blotch**

Resistance management strategy for:

Group 3	Demethylation inhibitors (DMI);
Group 7 + 3	Succinate dehydrogenase inhibitor (SDHI) + DMI;
Group 11	Quinone outside Inhibitors (QoI); and
Group 3 + 11	DMI + QoI.

Guidelines

1. Not all listed products are registered for all diseases. Ensure the product is registered for the disease being targeted.
2. **Do not** apply more than three consecutive **Group 3** sprays alone, before changing to a fungicide of a different activity group.
3. Apply a maximum of five **Group 3** sprays per season.
4. **Do not** apply **Group 11** or **Group 7** containing products as more than 50% of the total number of sprays in any one season, up to a maximum of three sprays of **Group 11**.
5. **Do not** apply more than two consecutive applications of a **Group 7+3** or **Group 11** spray.
6. If two consecutive applications of a **Group 7+ 3** or **Group 11** spray are applied, they must be followed by at least the same number of sprays from an alternative chemical group.
